Our goal is to develop a first checklist of ciliates for Guam. We hope that everyone who collects will be able to give us names of at least some of the taxa they collect, and we fully expect that many collections will include new species. You are under no obligation or time constraint to send back information, but all who do will be co-authors on the checklist. We will not hurry this checklist, anticipating that collectors will want to write up new species and publish details of new records first. The checklist will merely summarize those papers and any additional records.
